Jesus returned to Galilee

- In the power of the Spirit. v. 14
- He taught in synagogues and was glorified by all. v. 15
- It was His custom to enter on the Sabath day into the synagogue to read. v.
 16

Proclaimed the Jubilee (vv. 18-19)

- The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me
- To announce the gospel
- To proclaim release
- To recover sight
- To send away the oppressed
- To proclaim the year of Jubilee
- All the hearers marveled at the words of grace.
- But some were filled with anger and cast Him out of the city.

His fourfold commission

- Taught with authority. vv. 31-32
- With authority, cast out demons. v. 36
- Healed the sick. v. 40
- Preached the gospel of the kingdom of God. v. 43

Our inspiration

- The incarnated Man-Savior, Jesus Christ—He is anointed by God and is full of the Spirit.
