He journeyed (vv. 1-3)

- He journeyed from city to city and from village to village, <u>preaching</u> and <u>announcing</u> the gospel of the kingdom of God.
- The twelve were with Him.
- Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Susanna, and many other women ministered to them.

Teaching with parables (vv. 4-18)

- The **Sower** went out to sow the word of God was being spread.
 - · Some seed fell beside the way, was trampled, and the birds devoured it.
 - · Some fell on the rock, and withered.
 - · Some fell in the midst of the thorns and were choked off.
 - · Some fell into the good earth, and produced fruit, a hundredfold.
- One who lights a lamp
 - · No one covers it or puts it underneath a bed.
 - · But **puts it on the lampstand** that those who come in may see the light.
- Nothing is hidden which shall not become manifest.

Identifying His real relatives (vv. 19-21)

"My mother and My brothers are these who hear the word of God and do it."

Quelling the storm (vv. 22-25)

- A windstorm came down upon the lake and they were in danger.
- He rebuked the wind and the surging of the water, and they ceased.

Casting out a legion of Demons (vv. 26-39)

- A man who had demons met Him; Jesus charged the unclean spirit to come out.
- His name was "Legion" because many demons had entered into him.
- Jesus permitted them to enter a herd of many hogs.
- They entered the hogs which rushed down the steep slope into the lake and were drowned. Those who saw fled.
- They asked Jesus to depart from them, for they were in fear.
- But Jesus sent the man away, "Return to your house, and relate what great things God has done for you."

Healing a woman with a flow of blood and raising up a dead girl. (vv. 40-56)

- A ruler of the synagogue fell at Jesus' feet and entreated Jesus to enter his house for his only daughter was dying.
- On the way, a woman who had a flow of blood for twelve years, approached Him.
- She touched the fringe of His garment, and instantly her flow of blood stopped. "Your faith has healed you."
- At the same time, the ruler's daughter died.
- Jesus went and took hold of her hand and called out, saying, "Child, arise!" Her spirit returned.

** Our realization of the gospel

- Jesus carried out His ministry through His journeying from city to city and from village to village, to preach and to teach. We have an example to follow.
- He is the One who has the authority. We need to be one with Him.
- Do not be afraid, only believe.
- Your faith has healed you.
