The Golden Lampstands (for week of January 14, 2024)

Message One The lampstands are the churches

- I. John saw churches as lampstands, "The seven lampstands are the seven churches"
- II. The testimony of the church should shine forth to believers and unbelievers
- III. Believers should display their light, just as a lamp should be put on a lampstand
 - a. A light is not put under a basket, a bed, nor away in the cellar. A container is not put over the lamp.

¹⁴"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶"Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven. Matthew 5:14–16

²¹And He was saying to them, "A lamp is not brought to be put under a basket, is it, or under a bed? Is it not brought to be put on the lampstand? Mark 4:21

¹⁶"Now no one after lighting a lamp covers it over with a container, or puts it under a bed; but he puts it on a lampstand, so that those who come in may see the light. Luke 8:16

³³"No one, after lighting a lamp, puts it away in a cellar nor under a basket, but on the lampstand, so that those who enter may see the light. Luke 11:33

- b. A lampstand allows the light to shine.
- c. People who see the shining lampstand will see your good works and glorify your Father
- IV. The church is the household of God, the pillar of the truth, a dwelling of God in spirit, which bears a testimony to the people on earth.
